### Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

Mandatory conditions where the licence authorises the supply of alcohol:

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- (3) (a) Intoxicating liquor shall not be sold or supplied on the premises otherwise than to persons taking table meals there and for consumption by such a person as an ancillary to his meal.
  - (b) Suitable beverages other than intoxicating liquor (including drinking water) shall be equally available for consumption with or ancillary to meals served on the premises.
